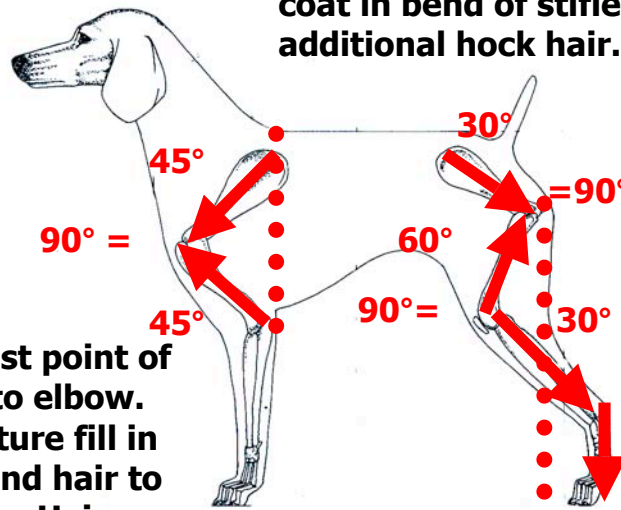


Quick tip: Imagine a line from pin bone straight down to in front of toes with hock straight. If toes are in front of the line then shorten coat in bend of stifle and leave additional hock hair.



Quick tip: Highest point of shoulder equal to elbow. To correct structure fill in with neck hair and hair to back of front leg. Hair on front of front leg may need to be shortened.



Poodles

Head: Clip from top inside of ear to out side corn of eye against grain with #10, #15, #30 or #40 Depending on Poodle skin condition. Continue to end of the muzzle. Then start just above where the poodle's neck curves in and clip up to the chin, then clip from same point to bottom out side of ear. Try longest universal comb over top knot then comb side to side and scissor.

Neck - Top line- Body- Use #4 or #3 on body create level top line, leave enough neck hair to blend and create additional neck if needed and follow angulation. Select a blade that creates a well sprung rib on your poodle.

Front Legs: Straight from every angle but set under dog to create good structure and clean over view. Select either a 1/2 in. or 3/4 in. comb down front of front leg and 1 in. everywhere else.

Rear Legs: Use your 1/2 in or 3/4 in comb attachment to create bend in rear and a 1 in. comb attachment on rest of leg with exception of hock.
